

Our projector is set up to handle HD images:

1920 x 1080

If you set the 1920 horizontal value, it will automatically adjust the vertical one to maintain the same aspect ratio. Depending on sensor size the vertical 1080 may be EXCEEDED - please be aware of this and check both settings before uploading. If the dimensions are exceeded, the image will be larger than screen and part of it will be truncated.

On the other hand a setting of 1024 x 768 will work, the entire image will project, but the screen image will be smaller - about half size.

DPE settings for any images should be between 72 – 200 DPI.

Prints for Contests

Large = 11 x 14 inches

Small = 8 x 12 inches

Size: Minimum size is 5 x 7

The photographer's name and title of the print must appear on the back of the mounted print in the upper right hand corner.
